# 3 Baking Soda *Alternatives* For Your Pets

## 1. Cleaning Products

## 2. Shampoos

## 3. Flea Repellents

1. Clean pet accidents by applying a little club soda to the accident. Let it dry thoroughly. Then sprinkle baking soda and let it set for about an hour and then vacuum.

2. Make a shampoo by mixing 1-quart hydrogen peroxide, ¼ cup baking soda and 1 tsp mild dishwashing detergent in a bucket. Use this solution like you would dog shampoo. Lather and rinse. Make sure to use a cloth to apply to the face area. Rinse well.


3. Kill those fleas. Be sure to treat bedding, carpets and furniture. Combine equal parts of baking soda and salt and place it in a shaker bottle. **Be sure to put pets in a separate area since the mixture will irritate your pet.** Liberally sprinkle the baking soda and salt mixture on bedding, furniture and carpet. Use a brush or broom to evenly distribute. Let it stay overnight and then vacuum. This will dehydrate and eventually kill fleas. Plan to repeat the process every three – four days. You should then be able to go to a monthly frequency.

# 3 Baking Soda Uses For *Plants*

Combine a teaspoon of baking soda and 1/3 cup of olive oil. After you mix it together, add one cup of water. Put the solution in a spray bottle. Spray every three days until your problem is gone.

Get rid of those pesky ants by combining baking soda and confectioners' sugar and vinegar. Make sure you use confectioners' sugar. The ants can spot regular sugar from confectioners' sugar. When you use confectioners' sugar, they will eat the sugar and the baking soda. Use equal parts confectioners' sugar and baking soda. After you apply the baking soda/sugar mixture to the ant hill pour a little white vinegar or apple cider vinegar to get rid of any stubborn stragglers.

Deal with weeds and crabgrass. If you have weeds or crabgrass growing in the cracks of your pavement, you can eliminate them by pouring a thick layer over the weeds. Be sure to moisten the area with water before applying the baking soda. The soda will burn the unwanted foliage.



# 5 Ways to use Baking Soda with *Food*

1. Dust a little baking soda on the skin of the chicken. Rub the baking soda in, add your seasonings and then place it in the oven and bake as usual.
2. Add a half-teaspoon of baking soda for every three eggs you use for fluffy omelets.
3. Add just a little baking soda to buttermilk waffle mix to make those waffles light and soft.
4. Tenderize meat and poultry by rubbing the cavity with baking soda and putting it in the refrigerator overnight. For meat, sprinkle small pieces of meat and then place it in the refrigerator over night. Rinse before cooking.
5. Clean produce with two or three tablespoons of baking soda and cold water.
